The team who come to transfer your baby will introduce themselves to you and explain how they will transfer your baby.

They are a specialist team trained to care for sick newborn and premature babies.

There will be a Doctor / Advanced

Neonatal Nurse Practitioner (ANNP),

Neonatal Nurse and an Ambulance Driver.

All are specially trained in neonatal transport.

The ambulance carrying your baby will have all the necessary specialist equipment to continue your baby's care and ensure their safe transfer to a local neonatal unit.

Parking

There are a number of parking areas available: there is a drop off point and a number of disabled parking spaces available outside the main entrance

Parking is free for parents of babies on NNU and TC. This is arranged by the nursing staff.

By rail

Basingstoke train station is 1.6 miles away from the hospital

By bus

The Foundation Trust is serviced by regular buses from Basingstoke town centre

The bus routes stopping at the site are numbers 2 and 4 and the link service
